

Promotion Policy

Class -XII

Public examination is held by CBSE for Class XII in the month of March and results are declared as per CBSE exam byelaws. To give enough practice for the Board Exam , Unit tests and various exams are conducted by the school according to the scheme of examinations. Pre-Board Examinations will be held in the month of December, i.e. before the Board Examination. The students are advised to take these examinations seriously as these exams will be beneficial for their preparation of the Board examination. All the exams are mandatory for all students and as per CBSE byelaws 75% attendance is mandatory to appear for the final exam in Class-XII. Adequate preparatory leaves are given before the commencement of Pre-Boards & Term Exams. Parents should discourage children from taking any additional leaves.

CLASS – XI

A weightage of 25% from U.T. 25% from I Term and 50% from II Term will be taken to calculate final result .A student needs to procure at least 40 % in each subject to obtain promotion to Class-XII. It is compulsory to obtain minimum of 40% marks separately in theory and practical in the subject involving practical examination. 75% attendance in mandatory to appear for the final examination in Class XI.
