### **Highlights of the Workshop**

For grades IV & V (20<sup>th</sup> till 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2017)

- Started with an interactive session.
- Informed the students about the meaning of the word “responsibility” and asked the question “Who is the most important person in their life”?
- Conducted an activity as to how we should feel responsible for the work that we do.
- Enlightened the students about the importance of making a role model and how we all feel connected with our role models and wish to become like them one day.
- Stressed on the fact that dreams don’t work unless we do and how to pursue our dream in a synchronized way.
- Raised awareness among teachers regarding how they can help a child towards his/her holistic growth and development.
- Made all the students play a game that will help them in enhancing their concentration power.
- Gave a precise difference between being mentally present and mentally balanced.
- Gave definitions of terms like “Counting on”, “Hard work”, “Responsibility”.
