- 2 teams have participated from our school and following models were displayed by the mentioned students :-

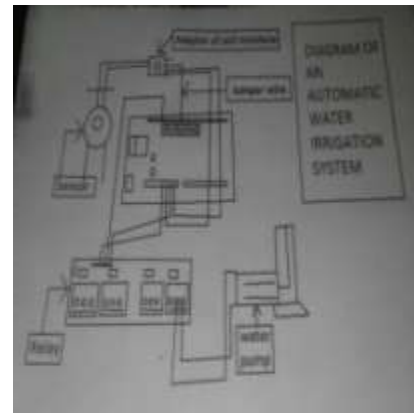
