Delegates:

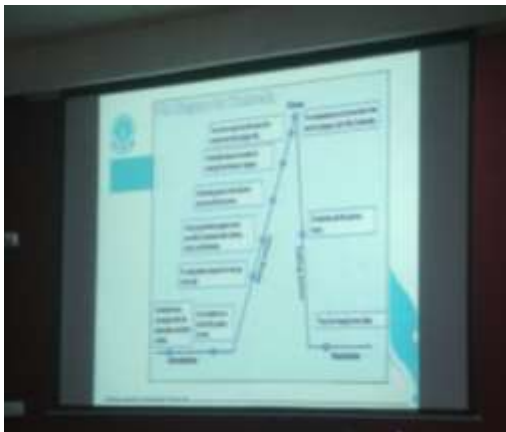
