**OBJECTIVE** :How to understand the Comprehension in French language.To know about the new vocabulary related to a house and to find the answers themselves.

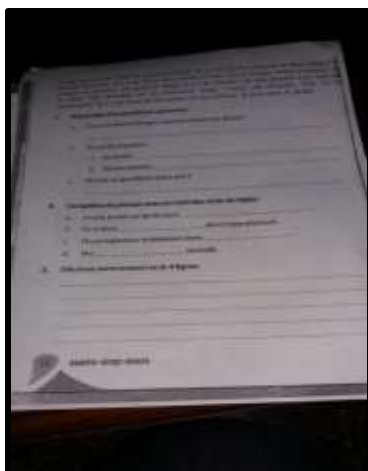
: Vocabulary introduced: La chambre (room), la cuisine(kitchen), la salle de bain(bathroom), les escaliers(stairs), etc.
