Students were happy on their first day and it will definitely be a cherished memory.

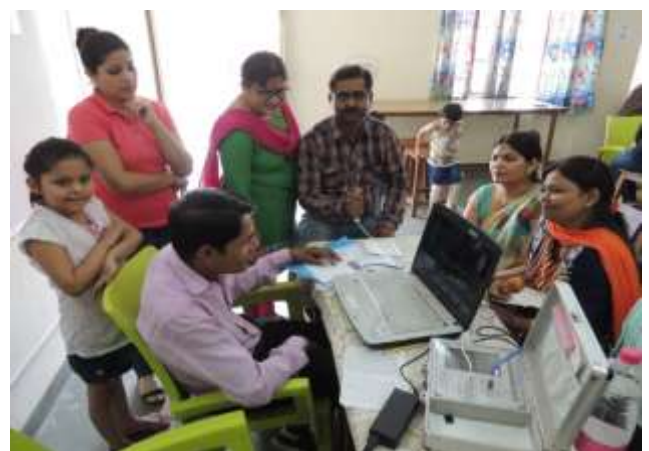
Students were familiarized with the new teachers and the school environment. Parents were happy to see their child enjoying on their first day.
