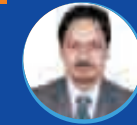

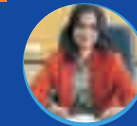
Keeping this in mind, Vidya Bharati School is committed to provide quality education, engaging students in multifarious activities for their holistic development and exposing them to learning beyond books.

Admission Procedure

- Candidates must be registered with the school prior to appearance in competency assessment.
- For registration, parents should obtain the prospectus cum admission form on payment from the School's Front Office.
- A child seeking admission to Pre- Nursery must complete 2 years as on 31 March. An attested copy of the original birth certificate issued by the competent authorities must be submitted along with the registration form.
- Registration does not guarantee admission.
- Reservation of seats in all classes as per Central Government/ UP Government/ Ghaziabad Development Authority guidelines for Economically Weaker Section of the Society.

Competency Level Assessment

For grades I to XI, the candidate has to appear for a competency assessment and qualify it. For Pre- Nursery and Prep grades, it is based on interaction with parents and students.

Fee and Funds

To be notified at the time of admission.

Mode of Payment of School Fee

The school accepts tuition fee through cheque only.

- Fee Queries from 2.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. (Mon. – Fri)

Recommendations to Parents/Guardians

- You are requested to monitor the progress of your ward carefully. In case you feel that your ward is not making satisfactory progress, you should contact the PRE/ Coordinator/Principal.
- You are required to bring all legitimate complaints to the notice of the Principal.
- Criticism / whisper campaigning should be avoided.
- You are requested to deposit fee on time to avoid reminders / late payment fine.
- You are requested to ensure that your ward comes to school properly and neatly dressed.
- You are not allowed to meet your ward during school hours.
- In case of emergency, you have to seek permission of the Principal after informing the Front Office Executive.
- You are not allowed to go to the classroom and meet the teacher except on PTM day.
- Fee must be paid latest by 10th of every month/quarter. In case 10th happens to be a holiday, the next working day shall not attract any late fine. Thereafter late fine is liable to be imposed.
- As per the First reminder regarding absence of a student for 5 consecutive days and Second reminder regarding absence for 7 days without information /non- payment of fee without any valid reason may render a student liable to have his/her name struck off from school rolls. Re-admission of the student will only be at the sole discretion of school authorities.
- Dishonoured cheque shall attract a fine of Rs.250/- as service charge along with the late fee. The said amount will be payable by DD / Cash.
- School Transport facility can be availed by the students on the routes designed by the School Transport Dept.
- In case of discontinuation of School bus facility, one month advance notice from the parents/guardians is required in writing.
- No withdrawal of bus facility in the last quarter will be entertained particularly in grade X & XII.

Withdrawal

Parents/Guardians who wish to withdraw their ward at the end of the term have to give a notice of one month in writing prior to the commencement of the next term, failing which they will have to pay full fee for the whole term. Students withdrawn during the middle of the term will be required to pay full fee for the whole term.



Breach of Discipline

- In case of any damage to the property of the school, it will be recovered from the student through fines, following the process.
- Any misbehaviour or violation of school discipline will be dealt with by the Disciplinary Committee.
- Corrective action will be taken- issue of warning cards / indiscipline card/ undertaking from the parent.
- Counselling session with Counsellor/ Special Educator.
- In extreme cases, parents/guardians will be called to discuss the child's behaviour and it may lead to suspension of the student from the school.
