**Objective:** To make students aware about the Heritage of India.

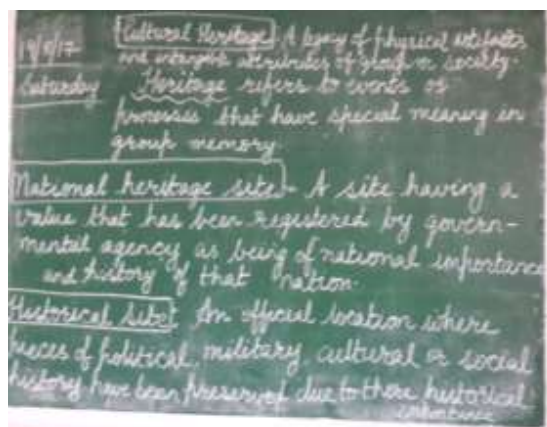
To inculcate the value of participation
